

Status of the Site Selection Process

NWMO Site Selection Process

- NWMO's objective is to identified preferred site by the end of 2023
- NWMO would enter into a hosting agreement
- NWMO has a separate engagement and willingness process with SON

NWMO Site Selection Timeline



Municipality of South Bruce Willingness Process

2020

- Conducted Visioning Workshop and report
- Entered MYFA & hired new staff
- Public consultation on the Guiding Principles
- Approved the 36 Guiding Principles

2021

- Retained consulting team for studies and peer reviews
- Conducted Willingness Study
- Instructed staff to prepare for referendum when draft hosting agreement is ready

2022

- Negotiate and approve MOU with the NWMO
- Receiving results of studies and peer reviews
- Prepare framework for negotiation of draft hosting agreement

Planned Future Activities

- Complete studies and peer reviews
- Negotiate draft hosting agreement
- Approve question for referendum on willingness
- Conduct referendum on willingness

Review of the MOU

Purpose and Effect of the MOU

- The ultimate objective is to negotiate a draft hosting agreement with the NWMO that secures benefits for the community and mitigation of any potential impacts
- The community can evaluate the studies and draft hosting agreement to make an informed decision on willingness by way of a referendum
- ▶ The MOU is an initial step in the negotiating process signals intention to move forward and establishes parameters for the negotiation of the draft hosting agreement

Key Provisions of the MOU

- Key provisions
 - For discussion purposes only and is not legally binding or enforceable
 - Does not constitute community consent to siting of the Project
 - Project scope includes DGR, Centre of Expertise and other associated buildings
 - Identifies NWMO commitments in response to the Principles
 - To determine a process for negotiating a draft hosting agreement

Project Scope

- ▶ The MOU states that the Project will only house Canadian used nuclear fuel waste, such as that generated from previous and current nuclear generating stations in Canada or arising from Atomic Energy of Canada Limited's operations
- Low and intermediate level waste produced as part of the operations of the DGR will be sent to a licensed facility or stored at the site

- NWMO Commitments provided in response to each of the Principles that apply to NWMO
- Commitments will require further development and refinement as part of negotiating the hosting agreement; they are not intended to be final statements

- Commitments related to future regulatory processes
