Oversize/Overweight Permit Application

Issued Under Section 110 of the Highway Traffic Act

PROVISIONS AND CONDITIONS

PERMIT IS NOT VALID:

1. On any road or highway other than roads under the jurisdiction of the Municipality of South Bruce
2. On Municipality of South Bruce roads under construction or during load restriction periods as determined from time to time.
3. On Saturdays, Sundays and Statutory Holidays except Easter Monday and Remembrance Day when Remembrance
4. Day falls on Monday to Friday inclusive.
5. In congested traffic conditions when the overall width exceeds 3.05 metres (10 feet) or the overall length exceeds 24.5 metres (80 feet).
6. From 2 hours after sunset to 2 hours before sunrise or at any other time when, due to insufficient light or unfavourable atmospheric conditions, persons and vehicles on the road are not clearly discernible at a distance of 150 metres or less.

CONDITIONS:

1. All conditions that are contained on the Ontario Ministry of Transportations Permit shall apply to this permit.
2. When transporting a load in excess of 3.7 metres in width an escort proceed and follow the vehicle.
3. A photocopy of this permit and an original of the Ontario Ministry of Transportations permit must be carried in the vehicle and produced on demand of a police officer or an officer for carrying out enforcement of the Highway Traffic Act.
4. The permit is issued on the condition the permit holder accepts responsibility for any and all damage that may be caused to overhead wires, structures, roads, encroachments, or railway rights-of-ways.
